## Travel information

### From M5

Leave the M5 at Junction 19.

After leaving the M5 at Junction 19 take the A369 marked “Easton-in-Gordano, Clifton (Toll)” and later “Bristol”. After about three miles there is a major set of traffic lights. After these lights make sure you are in the left hand lane sign posted “Clifton B3129 via toll bridge”. This lane will bear to the left on to Bridge Road and bring you to the Clifton Suspension Bridge. You will need 50 pence in ten, twenty or fifty pence coins for the toll.

Having crossed the Suspension Bridge continue on this road. Once you have passed over a zebra crossing you will come to a mini-roundabout. You take the second exit to bring Christ Church (the large Church with a spire) to your right hand side. At the T-junction by this Church turn right.

Drive to the bottom of Clifton Park and turn left. After going over a zebra crossing you will see the Cathedral on your left.

## From M4

Leave the M4 at Junction 19 and join the M32 towards Bristol.

You will pass under a bridge that has a sign telling you that you are coming to the end of the M32. You now need to be in the right hand lane of the motorway.

You are actually following the signs for the Zoo - brown signs with an elephant on! At the roundabout take the second exit.

After taking the second exit you will pass the Bus Station on your left. As you go through a set of traffic lights and begin to pass the Bristol Royal Infirmary on the right you need to be in the left hand lane so that you can continue straight on through the next set of traffic lights.

You will pass an Esso garage on your left as you continue up the hill. You will come to another set of traffic lights just before which the road splits into two lanes. You need to be in the right hand lane. You will pass through a second set of traffic lights and then follow the road round to the right moving into the left hand lane.

Follow the one-way system. You will see the Victoria Rooms and the fountains in front of you. Bear left on to Queens Road, which is the third turning to the left.

Continue up this road until you come to two mini roundabouts. Go over first and turn right at the second on to Pembroke Road. You will pass Channings Hotel on your right and then go over a zebra crossing. The Cathedral is on your left.

## Parking

### Clifton Cathedral

The car park underneath the Cathedral is available to guests on a first come first served basis.

Alternative parking is available. Details of two public car parks are below. However, please be aware that Bristol operates a very strict parking policy and any cars which are illegally parked will be towed away.

### Whiteladies Road Shopping Centre

The nearest is at the Whiteladies Road Shopping Centre. Having passed the Cathedral on your left continue along Pembroke Road and take the second road on the right - Alma Road. The Car Park is towards the end of this road on the left

### North End NCP Car Park

This is in a one-way system so you will need to drive down Jacob's Wells Road and then come back up the hill to get into the car park. There is a roundabout at the bottom of Jacob's Wells road so that you can turn easily. The walk to the Cathedral is uphill!

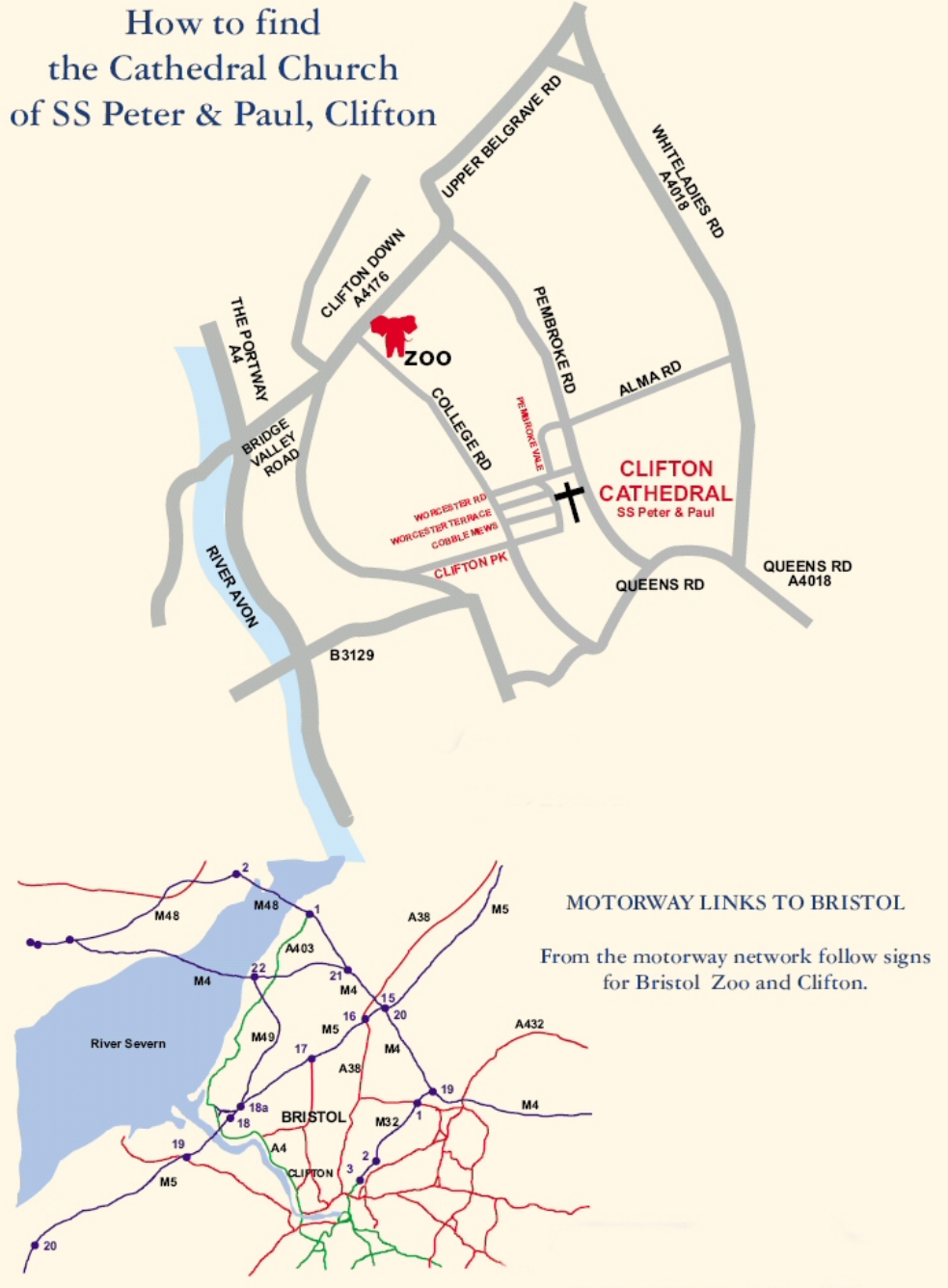
